
winter season. Tickets are already on sale on the carrier's website; flights will be operated from 29 October 2025.

Asiana Airlines Operates the Prague – Seoul Route



As is proper and appropriate, the aircraft was welcomed with a water salute. With the kind permission of the airline, we then invited journalists, partners, and other guests to tour the aircraft. The Airbus A350-900 can accommodate up to 311 passengers and in the colours of Asiana Airlines will fly between Prague and Seoul three times a week all year round – on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. Thanks to this addition, the connection to the South Korean metropolis is now available on a daily basis.



PragBus Connects Prague with Chemnitz



A new direct coach service to Václav Havel Airport Prague from the German city of Chemnitz, the European Capital of Culture 2025, is now available. The new PragBus line will be operated by the Central Saxony Transport Association (Verkehrsverbund Mittelsachsen, VMS) between Prague and Chemnitz twice a day until 2 November, and then again from 28 to 30 November 2025. The new route was officially launched at Václav Havel Airport Prague on 7 April 2025.
