Prague Airport Foresees Record-breaking Summer Season

From 30 March to 25 October 2025, passengers will be able to choose from 165 destinations, served by 75 airlines. The main news includes the return of Air Canada with a direct route to Toronto, strengthening of the Seoul connection by Asiana Airlines, and the new Etihad Airways service to Abu Dhabi. Air Baltic adds Vilnius

operation, thus re-connecting Prague with all Baltic capitals, while Croatia Airlines launches a route to Zagreb.



Resumed Prague – Bordeaux Connection by easyJet and Volotea



easyJet will launch a new route from/to Bordeaux with a two-weekly frequency (Mon, Fri) from 27 October 2025 (from the start of the W25 season). The route will be operated using Airbus A320 aircraft for 186 passengers. This is the carrier's 22nd route from PRG. Moreover, the operation of the route from/to Bordeaux will be enhanced by Volotea and its twice weekly services operated from 26 November 2025 to 4 January 2026 with an Airbus A320 for 180 passengers.



Czech Citizens Now Need ETA Permit to Travel to the UK

Citizens of EU member states, including the Czech Republic, will need to obtain the ETA (Electronic Travel Authorisation) to travel to the United Kingdom starting 2 April 2025. The British government is gradually introducing this system for all countries which have visa-free regimes with the UK.
