Croatia Airlines Inaugurates Prague – Dubrovnik Service



On 18 May, Prague Airport and Croatia Airlines celebrated the launch of the airline's new route from Prague to Dubrovnik. The first flight took a form of an event with traditional catering offered to the departing passengers and ceremonial cake cutting done by Mr. Mato Radić, Area Manager for Central Europe, Croatia Airlines, and Mr. Martin Tatek, Route Development Manager, Prague Airport. The route to Dubrovnik is Croatia Airlines' second route from Prague, as it currently also operates the Prague – Split connection.



Wizz Air Announces New Route from Prague to London Gatwick



The airline has added another route from Prague to London, confirming the British metropolis as the number one destination from the Czech capital. Wizz Air, which currently operates flights from Prague to Luton, has announced it will add London Gatwick to their route network from Prague Airport starting 29 October 2023. The new route will be operated every day except Thursdays.



Two Airlines to Start Operating Flights to East Midlands this Autumn



Britain is a popular outgoing as well as incoming destination from Prague, with a very strong potential. Another proof of this fact is that on top of Jet2.com's announcement of the new route from Prague Airport to East Midlands, published in the last issue of the newsletter, this month, Ryanair has confirmed it will start operating the Prague – East Midlands route, too. Ryanair will commence its operations of the new route on 30 October 2023 with twice weekly flights (every Monday & Thursday).



Eurowings Announces New Destination from Prague: Tbilisi



Eurowings plans to start operating flights from Prague to Tbilisi, the capital of Georgia, from the beginning of this Winter Season. The route will be operated with Airbus A319 for 150 passengers on Mondays & Fridays.
