Routes Asia Wrap-up & Routes Europe Awards Voting

Last week, Prague Airport representatives returned from Routes Asia, where they successfully concluded 15 meetings with key players of the Asian aviation market. A very promising development in the process of establishing a number of new direct air connections from Prague in a foreseeable future has been recognised.

New Direct Routes from Prague Announced

Wizz Air is to launch a new route to Armenia's capital city. A direct connection between Prague and Yerevan was last served in 2018. The airline will connect the two capitals twice weekly, every Monday and Friday, effective 26 June. On 1 July, Ryanair will launch its new route from Prague to Seville. Coincidentally, this route has also been operated for the last time in 2018. This new destination will be served twice weekly, every Tuesday and Saturday.



Expansion of Routes from Prague to Croatia



Starting this May, Prague Airport will enjoy a new connection to Dubrovnik. The route will be operated once a week, every Thursday, by Croatia Airlines' Airbus A319 with a capacity of 144 seats. The route will be available from 18 May until 12 October. The airline will also increase the number of frequencies on its Prague – Split route to twice weekly.



Eurowings Anniversary & Further Expansion of Network from Prague



In October, we celebrated 1st Anniversary of the Eurowings base at Prague Airport and this month, the airline is celebrating a beautiful 30 years since its founding. The growth of Eurowings in Prague will continue even in the Summer 2023 Season. The carrier has announced new routes to Geneva, Zakynthos, Rhodes and Corfu for their summer schedule from Prague. Further, it will increase frequencies on numerous routes, for example Cologne, Stockholm, Athens, Barcelona & Alicante, aside others.

Prague Airport deeply sympathises with victims of the devastating earthquake that affected Turkey and Syria this month. On Friday directly following the events, a special Smartwings flight departed Prague and headed to Adana with members of the Czech Republic Firefighters' Urban Search and Rescue Team.
