Korean Air Starts Its Service from Prague to Seoul

On 27th March, the inaugural Korean Air flight from Seoul to Prague took place. The route to Seoul will be operated three times a week (every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday) for now with an added Saturday frequency from June, as confirmed by the airline team during the inaugural event. The celebrations were attended by numerous distinguished guests including the Korean Embassy representative, Mrs. Eun Young Seo, the mayor of Prague, Mr. Bohuslav Svoboda, the Regional Manager of Korean Air, Mr. Hyunseung Kim, and Prague Airport CEO, Mr. Jiří Pos.



China Airlines Confirms New Route from Prague to Taipei

On 18th July, Prague Airport is to gain a new long-haul destination. China Airlines will start flying from Taipei, Taiwan, to Prague with their Airbus A350-900 for 306 passengers. The route will be operated twice a week, with departures from Prague every Wednesday and Sunday.



Frequencies Increased on Connections to Major European Hubs

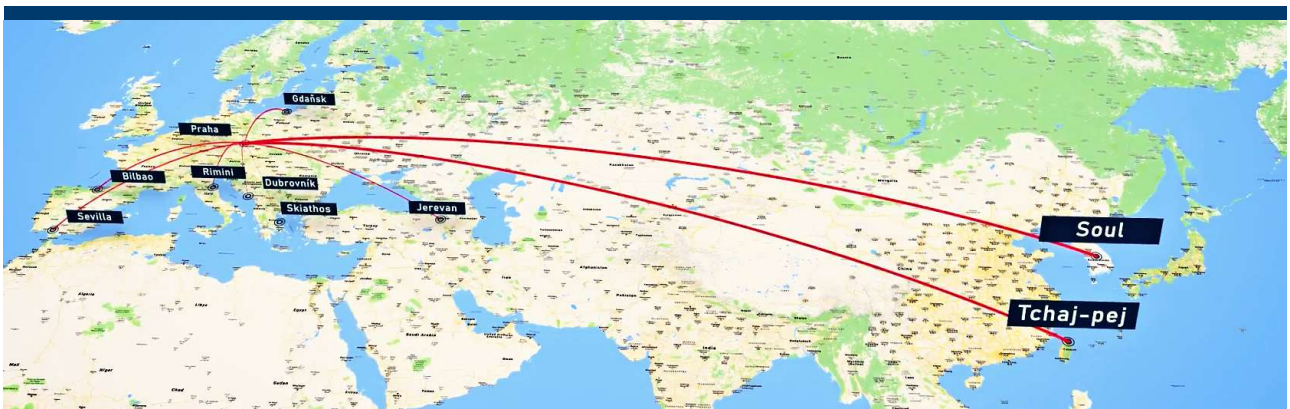
The new season has also brought many frequency increases on routes from Prague to several European hubs. British Airways will now be flying to London Heathrow up to six times daily, while Air France has increased its frequency from Prague to Paris to four times daily on most days. Both Lufthansa and KLM will be connecting Prague with their hubs, Frankfurt and Amsterdam respectively, up to five times daily. From 15th May, Finnair is to add a new morning frequency to the carrier's schedule from Prague, effectively increasing the number of its daily flights to three.



easyJet Announces New Route to Lyon



Starting this September, easyJet will commence operations on the route from Prague to Lyon. The new connection will be operated twice weekly, every Monday and Friday, all year round, thus becoming the airlines 12th route from Prague this season.



2023 Summer Season Brings Many Network Additions



Currently, the summer schedule includes 65 airlines serving a total of 152 destinations available directly to and from Prague. There are 7 new airlines joining us at Prague Airport during this season and passengers will now be able to pick from 11 brand new destinations, including the above-mentioned Seoul and Taipei as well as, for example, Gdansk, Rimini, Yerevan, Seville, Bilbao, and more.
