NEW TRAVEL RULES FOR ARRIVALS IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC



With regard to the pandemic situation around the world, new measures apply on arrivals in the Czech Republic effective 5 February 2021. The travel traffic light system has been expanded with a fourth group of countries with a very high risk of COVID-19

virus transmission. Prior to boarding the aircraft, passengers travelling from these countries must complete the [Public Health Passenger Locator Form](#) and submit a negative PCR test result no older than 72 hours. After arrival, they are subject to a mandatory five-day quarantine, at the end of which they are obliged to undergo a second PCR test. In addition, according to the government regulation effective as of 25 February 2021, it is required to wear a FFP2 respirator or two surgical masks when on all public places. MORE PRAGUE – DUBAI FLIGHTS



Effective March 2021, Emirates is increasing the number of frequencies on its regular route between Prague and Dubai to up to five flights a week, while flydubai is increasing its direct service to Dubai to up to four weekly frequencies. As a result, passengers will also be able

to connect from Dubai to more distant destinations. Tickets are already available for purchase via the carriers' websites: www.emirates.com and www.flydubai.com. We recommend passengers always check all up-to-date rules of travel before their journey.

GREAT DEMAND FOR EGYPT FLIGHTS



Travel demand on flights from Prague to Egypt significantly increased in January compared to the last year. On direct flights to Hurghada and Marsa Alam, there were nearly 55% handled passengers more in January than during the same period in 2020.

Direct services to Hurghada are currently operated by two carriers – [Smartwings](#) and [Air Cairo](#) – up to 5 times a week. Smartwings fly to Marsa Alam as well up to 3 times a week. Before heading to Egypt, we recommend passengers pay attention to all currently valid rules of travel on both the Czech and the Egyptian side.

ACI GRANTS PRAGUE AIRPORT VOICE OF THE CUSTOMER AWARD



Prague Airport has received the Voice of the Customer award granted to airports, which, despite the demanding and unprecedented year 2020, paid increased attention to the positive customer experience as well as the comfort and safety of their passengers. This is the second

recognition of the airport in Prague received in a short time, confirming it is moving in the right direction with regard to passenger services and the protection of their health. Last November, Prague Airport received the ACI Airport Health Accreditation certificate, which confirms the high level of the measures taken to protect the health of both passengers and airport employees.
