Turkish Record-breaking Load on Passenger Flights

Turkish Cargo and Air Logistics are proud to share and announce the record-breaking loads on passenger flights from PRG operated by widebody aircraft. The TK1770 PRG-IST flight on 29th June, operated by passenger Boeing 777, uplifted a total of 34,384 kg of cargo. The high-density loads were scrupulously planned by the handling team (Enes Cargo) on 5 PMCs, 3 PAGs, 3 PLAs, and 1 PKC pallets. A week before, the same flight operated by passenger Airbus 330 carried 26,003 kg of cargo, making it a total of more than 60 tons of cargo carried on just two passenger flights.



Smartwings Grows Its European Network



Our home-based carrier boosts the list of European destinations! As of the winter season, Smartwings opens regular flights to Barcelona, Bilbao, Brussels, Bucharest, Porto, Rome, and Toulouse, all operated by brand new Airbus A220s.
