Prague Airport Shortlisted for Routes World Awards

Bees Airlines Launches Direct Connection to Prague



The largest spa in Europe and the famous Palace of the Parliament; Bees Airlines launches flights to Bucharest, Romania, on 23 August. The route will be operated three times a week by an Airbus A320 for 180 passengers.



Pyramids Are Now within Reach by EgyptAir Direct Flights

After thirteen years, Václav Havel Airport Prague has a resumed direct connection with Egyptian capital. On Monday, 9 July, the first EgyptAir flight to Cairo took place. The route is operated three times a week with Boeing 737-800 for 154 passengers and offers interesting options of transfers to connecting flights to various destinations in Africa.

For the first time in its history, Prague Airport offers direct flights to Mongolia. The connection between Prague and the capital of Ulaanbaatar is provided by the Eznis Airways carrier from 10. July. Two flights a week, every Wednesday and Saturday, are operated by a wide-body Airbus A330 with a capacity for 256 passengers. This third direct European route to Mongolia also supports transfers to connecting flights, for example, to Vietnam.

After two years, another gate party took place at Václav Havel Airport Prague for passengers heading from Prague to the legendary Tomorrowland festival. Everything was coordinated with Brussels Airlines, including the show by DJ 5NAPBACK for passengers.

In the first six months of this year, Václav Havel Airport Prague handled over seven million passengers, which represents a year-on-year increase of almost a quarter. The number of passengers in the first half of the year reached 92 percent of the 2019 record year. The most flights were operated to and from Great Britain, Italy, Spain, France, and Germany.
