### Three New Direct Routes from Prague Airport Announced

December is full of new announcements! The destination map of direct flights from Prague Airport is ever-growing, most recently with Aeroitalia's new route to and from Florence. The three-weekly service will commence on 27 March 2023. Just one day after that, Air Cairo will launch its new service to Marsa Alam, and on 31 March, easyJet will start operating on the Prague – Lisbon route.



### Review Meeting with Ministry of Transport & ANS CR

During a press conference held at the beginning of December, Prague Airport, Air Navigation Services of the Czech Republic, and the Ministry of Transport reviewed the situation and development of civil aviation in the Czech Republic. The event followed soon after Prague Airport reached the 10 million passengers handled mark.



# Inaugural Flight between Prague and Bucharest by Wizz Air



A new carrier is now operating on the Prague – Bucharest route. Wizz Air has celebrated their first flight to the Romanian capital on 2 December. The event was attended by both Prague Airport and Wizz Air representatives. The service adds two more frequencies on the route operated by Wizz Air's A321.



# Airlines Increasing Their Frequencies & Seats to & from Prague Airport

As the demand for travelling keeps growing, many airlines are increasing frequencies and seat offers on their Prague routes. Most recently, the following schedule expansions were announced by airBaltic, which will now operate on their route from Prague to Riga 4-5 times weekly (starting May), and Air Montenegro, adding 2 more frequencies compared to the last summer season's service. Last, but not least, Iberia has launched its daily service, which is to be operated by the carrier's Airbus A350 on Thursdays until 26 January.



### Prague Airport Recruitment Day Success

The recruitment campaigns do not stop at Prague Airport, even though the summer season was very well handled considering the difficult staffing situation at some other airports. Most recently, Prague Airport organised a recruitment day event, which was attended by more than 500 prospective job applicants.
