### 2022 Results Announced

Prague Airport has just published its yearly results along with 2023 prospects. In the press release, you can find, for example, that the total number of passengers in 2022 amounted to 10,734,880, a 145% year-on-year increase, and that 16 new destinations were launched within the year, for example New York, Kuwait, Muscat and Tivat. This year, it is expected that 12.5 million passengers will be handled at Prague Airport, with numerous new routes confirmed already.

Effective 27<sup>th</sup> March 2023, Korean Air starts flying from Prague Airport to the South Korean capital again.
