

15.5 million passengers expected in 2024

More information

In 2024, Prague Airport expects to handle 15.5 million passengers, to whom it will offer more than 170 destinations with increases in frequencies on more than 30 connections. For comparison, in 2019, Prague Airport offered 190 direct connections, of which 16 were destinations in the Russian Federation, Ukraine, and Belarus, on which operations are now disrupted.



Qatar Airways, in Cooperation with Prague Airport, Celebrates Boeing 787 Dreamliner's Comeback



The modern Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner is back on the route from Prague to Doha. Qatar Airways is, once again, using this aircraft for 254 passengers which operated the route before the Covid-19 pandemic. The modern wide-body machine brings more comfortable travel and 44 percent more capacity on this popular route. Last but not least, air cargo capacity will also be increased. The Dreamliner departs from Prague every day, while on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays there is also a second frequency, which continues to be operated by an Airbus A320.

Following the example of other international air hubs, for the third time, Prague Airport awarded the best airlines of the past year. The low-cost airline Ryanair won the title of the Fastest Growing Airline at Václav Havel Airport Prague. The Most Efficient Carrier in Terms of Traffic was Finnair. The title of the Top Sustainable Airlines was awarded to easyJet. British Airways won the award for the Best Airline Marketing Campaign with Prague Airport. Compared to last year, a category of the Most Developing Cargo Carrier was added with the title awarded to Korean Air.
