

SunExpress to Extend Operations of Direct Antalya Service

The direct route from Prague to Antalya by SunExpress will also be operated in the winter

season this year. This route has traditionally been operated during the summer months only. However, both outgoing demand and the route's potential in terms of incoming tourism to the Czech Republic (especially during the Advent time) may secure a successful direct connection between Prague and Antalya all year round!



Eurowings Network from Prague Airport Expands



Further expansion plans for this winter season were announced by Eurowings. The airline, based at our airport since last year, has been growing its network from Prague, resulting in a total of 13 destinations to be operated during the 2022/23 winter season. The recently announced new destinations include Hurghada, Larnaca, Marsa Alam, and Oslo.

RWY 06/24 back in service!



After almost a three months long planned renovation of the Prague Airport's main runway, aircraft started landing and taking off from RWY 06/24 again ahead of the schedule, on 30 June 2022.
