

Václav Havel Airport Prague Strategic Development in Coming Years

The development of our airport plays a vital role in the economic growth of tourism in the Czech Republic. The year 2019 marked our historical milestone in terms of the number of handled passengers. Unfortunately, the coming years were not as positive. However, air transport is gradually recovering after the end of the pandemic, and we at Prague Airport expect to return to the pre-pandemic results in 2026. By 2030, we are planning to offer 200 direct flights and 37 long-haul routes. Therefore, due to the expected increase in traffic in the coming years, the development of Prague Airport must also take place. Volotea to Service Verona from Prague



A new destination was announced by Volotea. The carrier will service Verona twice a week using Airbus A320s for 180 passengers. The route will be operated every Monday and Friday from 22 March 2024.



Launch of New Service to the East Midlands



Jet2.com has launched its new route to the East Midlands near Nottingham, which the carrier will operate every Monday and Friday. The inaugural flight also celebrated 20 years since the first Jet2.com's flight to Prague Airport.



Aboard Eurowings to Agadir



Eurowings has launched its new route to Agadir, Morocco, where you can now fly up to twice a week aboard Airbus A320s.



To Costa Blanca with easyJet



Travellers will be able to reach Alicante every Monday and Friday aboard easyJet regular service with its launch scheduled on 1 April 2024. Alongside easyJet, the Alicante route will be operated by Eurowings under the summer flight schedule.



Pegasus Airlines Turkish Riviera Service



The popular Turkish resort of Antalya will be available to you aboard Pegasus Airlines flights starting 19 May 2024. The route will be operated every Thursday and Sunday with the Airbus A320neo for 186 passengers, thus complementing the existing operations of Smartwings and SunExpress.



Qatar Dreamliner Returns to Prague Airport

Qatar Airways, which operates the Doha-Prague route ten times a week, will deploy the Boeing 787 Dreamliner on seven of its flights effective 1 January 2024.
