World2Fly and DER Touristik Launch Exotic Destination Charters



Prague now offers direct connections to two new exotic destinations, namely Santa Clara in Cuba and Phu Quoc in Vietnam. In addition, there is a new player on the route to Punta Cana in the Dominican Republic. World2Fly, in cooperation with the DER Touristik Group, has just launched their direct charter flights operated from Prague with modern A350-900 aircraft for 432 passengers.



LOT Bases Its B787 Dreamliner in Prague and Launches 2 New Destinations Working with Čedok



The cooperation between LOT Polish Airlines and the Čedok travel agency, which has been offering passengers direct flights from Prague to exotic destinations for the third year, has become even more fruitful this winter season. Together, they will offer a total of six destinations served by Boeing 787 Dreamliners. One of these modern aircraft will even be based in Prague for these purposes. Among the brand-new additions are Mombasa in Kenya, which will be operated from January 2024, and a new route to Colombo, Sri Lanka, which was ceremonially launched on 24 October.



Routes World Wrap Up



The Prague Airport Route Development team returned after successful participation at Routes World in Istanbul, the largest conference of its kind, where its members met with more than 50 valued airline partners during three intensive days of networking. SunExpress Announces Its New Route to Izmir



Starting next summer, it will be possible to fly from Prague to another Turkish city, making a total of three, aboard the new regular service of SunExpress. The airline will offer its new service to Izmir twice a week, every Wednesday and Sunday, from 5 June 2024. The route from Prague to the Turkish Aegean coast will be operated by Boeing 737-800 or Boeing 737 MAX 8 aircraft with a capacity of 189 seats.



Volotea to Service Florence from Prague



A new destination, and at the same time the airline's third from Prague, was announced by Volotea. The airline will fly from/to Florence twice a week with the Airbus A319 for 156 passengers. The route will be operated every Monday and Friday from 22 March 2024, making it an ideal connection for weekend getaways.
