



Successful Summer Season Wrapped-up



Prague Airport has successfully wrapped up the 2022 busy summer season and shared its [results](#) with media last week. Just between June and August, Prague Airport handled more than 3.8 million passengers, with the overall summer season numbers (until the end of August) at nearly 8 million. The busiest day of the year was 1st July when the number of passengers exceeded 50,000.

September offered fruitful opportunities for co-operation between airports. At the beginning of the month, Prague Airport representatives visited our sister airport, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport, to exchange best practices and materialise the MOU signed in 2019.

On top of that, just last week, Jiří Pos (CEO of Prague Airport) attended a meeting hosted by Julian Jäger (CEO of Vienna Airport). Airport CEOs from Prague, Budapest, Bratislava, Vienna, and Warsaw exchanged views on operations, ground handling, and other current issues.



Direct Flights from Prague to Exotic Destinations

The Czech travel agency Čedok is extending its offer of charter flights from Prague to exotic destinations to cover this winter season. Thanks to that, Prague Airport will add destinations like Nosy Be (Madagascar), and Krabi (Thailand) onto its route network map. The travel agency co-operates with various airlines to offer these routes, this season with Neos and LOT.



British Airways Resumes Its Route from Prague to London City

The resumed connection to London City means that passengers from Prague Airport will now be able to fly to five out of six major London airports. The service to London City will be available for passengers travelling from Prague from the beginning of the winter travel season with a three-times-weekly frequency, on Mondays, Fridays, and Sundays. London City airport is located in the very city centre of London. Thus, it is very convenient for both tourists and business travellers.



Air Moldova to Launch New Route from Prague to Chisinau



Prague Airport will have the pleasure of welcoming yet another new airline on its grounds! Launching scheduled operations on 30 October, Air Moldova will enter the Prague – Chisinau route market segment. Flights will be available three times a week, on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays.
