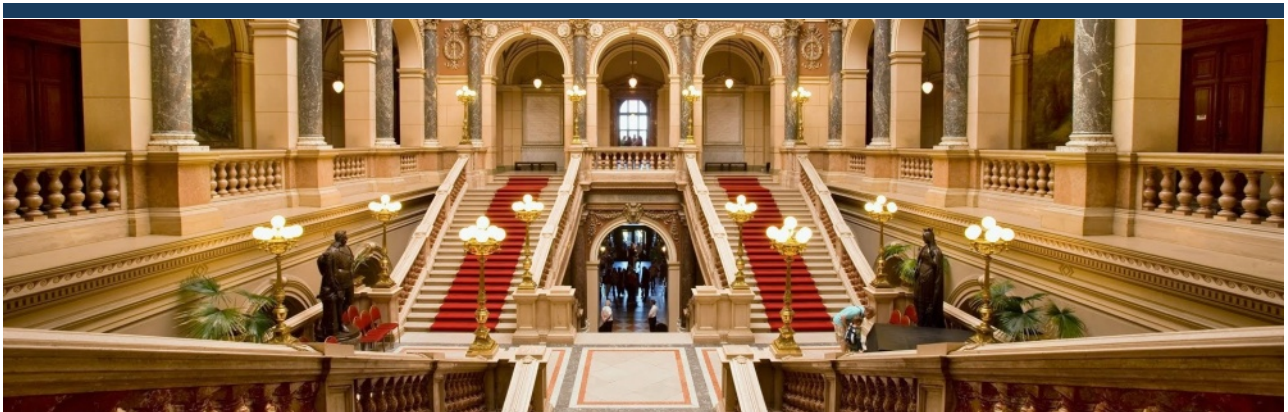


To Philadelphia with American Airlines
