INVESTMENT INTO TERMINAL 2 FIRST EXPANSION STAGE APPROVED



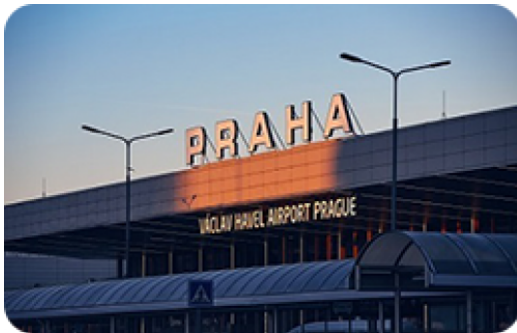
Prague Airport has introduced its long-term concept and development strategy covering the period until 2035. The airport is responding to the ever-increasing number of its passengers over the past few years. The Ministry of Finance of the Czech Republic, as the sole shareholder, approved the airport's investment of over CZK 16 billion to cover the first stage of the Terminal 2 expansion. The construction phase is anticipated to be completed in 2028. Other Prague Airport development projects, such as the parallel runway, the new terminal and AirportCity, will be approved gradually depending on the current situation and changes in the market.

PRAGUE AIRPORT RECEIVES IMPROVED RATING BY MOODY'S



Moody's Investors Service, a renowned rating agency, has upgraded Prague Airport's credit rating by one notch to Aa3 from A1 and changed its outlook from positive to stable. This action follows Moody's recent decision to change the rating of the Czech Republic in

the same way. Prague Airport Group thus continues to achieve the highest possible rating in the country. The key reasons for this upgrade still include stable cash flow, competitive airport charges, the company's excellent financial profile and its crucial role in national infrastructure.

Prague Airport has organised the 10th Annual St. Martin's Roadshow for travel agencies, tour operators and ticketing agents. The Roadshow introduced product updates to key business partners, namely new routes from/to Prague and services offered to passengers at the airport.

Delta Air Lines, American Airlines and United Airlines were, together with the U.S. Embassy in Prague and the Visit USA Committee, this year's partners of the event. Over 400 B2B guests visited the event between 11 and 19 November 2019 in a total of six cities across the Czech Republic, namely Ostrava, Olomouc, Zlin, Brno, Pilsen and Prague. This year's participation was, once again, record-breaking.

ROSSIYA AIRLINES TO FLY TO SAINT PETERSBURG DOUBLE DAILY



Rossiya Airlines has announced that effective the 2020 summer schedule, it will increase its number of flights between Prague and Saint Petersburg, Russia. Starting from 30 March 2020, the airline will add an additional flight on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays

to complement the existing ten flights a week. Rossiya Airlines will then fly double daily between the two cities. The direct route is operated by Airbus A320 Family aircraft. According to Prague Airport's estimates, over 20,000 passengers travelling in both directions will use the four new flights.

UPS AND PRAGUE AIRPORT TO COLLABORATE ON NOISE REDUCTION





Reducing environmental impact of airport operations is Prague Airport's long-term goal under which co-operation with all carriers is crucial. Prague Airport and UPS have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to collaborate on reducing the impact of cargo flights. The mutual

agreement provides a formal framework for co-operation through workshops and information exchange. Specifically, UPS and the airport will share knowledge and best practices on noise reduction measures from other airports and how they could be implemented in Prague.

PRAGUE AIRPORT TO RESTRICT SINGLE-USE PLASTICS



Prague Airport is launching a programme called ***Fly Plastic Free***, which aims to restrict the consumption of single-use plastics within the airport. Among other things, the aim is to motivate passengers to reduce the environmental impacts of their

travels, for example, by choosing reusable bottles for beverages. Moreover, if they buy beverages in single-use plastic bottles, they are offered the option of not throwing the bottles away but emptying them before the security check and continue to use them. They can now pour water out of their bottle into a sink before the security control in Terminal 2 and refill the bottle after passing the security screening at one of the drinking fountains around the airport.
