

CZECH AIRLINES CELEBRATES 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF ITS BUDAPEST SERVICE



Czech Airlines has commemorated the 80th anniversary of the launch of operations of its Budapest route. On Wednesday, 1 August 2018, working with the airline, Prague Airport prepared a ceremonial cake cutting and served small refreshments to passengers of the anniversary flight operated by ATR aircraft. This year, Czech Airlines

has already celebrated anniversaries of its Paris, St. Petersburg and Seoul services.

QATAR AIRWAYS CONFIRMS DREAMLINER SERVICE TO PRAGUE

Qatar Airways has officially announced that effective 28 October 2018, one of the two daily flights from



Prague to Doha will be serviced with Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner, increasing the overall capacity of the route by approximately 46%. The daily afternoon flights to Doha, the capital of Qatar, will use Boeing 787-8 Dreamliners with the capacity of 254 passengers, while the morning flights from Prague will continue to be operated with Airbus A320s for

132 passengers. Qatar Airways has decided to use a larger type of aircraft after about a year of operations of the route.

AIR ARABIA TO LAUNCH ITS PRAGUE-SHARJAH ROUTE



Air Arabia is launching its new regular scheduled route connecting Prague with Sharjah, the third largest city in the United Arab Emirates. The new connection will be operated five times a week effective 11 December 2018. The carrier will service the destination with Airbus A320s for 168 passengers in the Economy Class. We expect

the new route to be used by about 97 thousand passengers a year in both directions.

CYPRUS AIRWAYS TO EXTEND PRAGUE-LARNACA FLIGHTS THIS WINTER



Cyprus Airways has announced that it will continue operating flights to the Czech capital through the winter season. Cyprus Airways first launched its Prague - Larnaca route last June, with flights every Monday and Friday. The carrier's winter flights will be operated on the same days at different times.

TURKISH AIRLINES TO SERVICE ISTANBUL FOUR TIMES DAILY



Turkish Airlines will increase the number of its flights between Prague and Istanbul next year. Effective 27 May 2019, the carrier will add a fourth daily frequency to the existing three flights on the route. The new TK1773/1774 flights will be arriving in Prague at 12:15 p.m. and returning to the largest city in Turkey at 1:10 p.m. We expect the fourth daily

frequency to be used by 100 thousand passengers a year in both directions.
