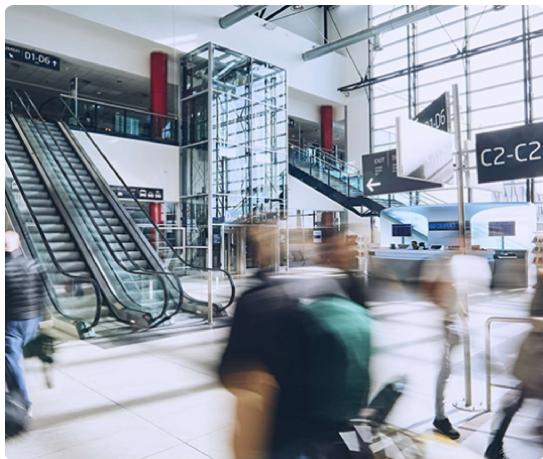

IN NOVEMBER, PRAGUE AIRPORT HANDLED OVER 540 THOUSAND PASSENGERS



The trend of an increasing number of handled passengers continued at Prague Airport in November 2021, when 544 592 passengers passed through the airport and 6 786 take-offs and landings were performed. The busiest destination became London where four international airports are currently served directly from Prague. As for the highest number of handled passengers, London was followed by

Paris, Amsterdam, Tel Aviv and Dubai in November. The list of the most frequented countries was topped by the United Kingdom, followed by Italy and France. In a year-on-year comparison, the airport handled approximately seven times more passengers in November 2021 than during the same period last year.

PRAGUE AIRPORT CONTINUES WITH TOUCHPOINT PROJECT

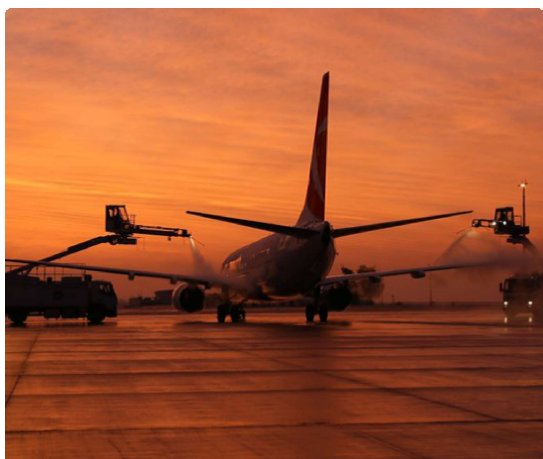
This December, representatives of



Prague Airport, CzechTourism and Prague City Tourism met at the invitation extended by Ms. Hana Třeštíková, Councillor of the Capital City of Prague for Culture, Monument Care, Exhibition and Tourism. The main topic of the meeting was the co-operation within the TouchPoint project, which aims at supporting the resumption and expansion of incoming tourism to the Czech Republic. The

participants have agreed on the common goal for 2022, i.e. support of destinations with direct air connections, which proves to be crucial to the incoming tourism recovery and development (countries such as the UK, Italy, Spain and France). In addition, significant attention will be paid to the United States with direct routes resumptions scheduled next year.

DECEMBER FLIGHT SCHEDULE ADDITIONS



Once again, a several new and resumed direct flights from Prague were added into the schedule in December 2021. Vueling has been flying to Amsterdam since 3 December. On 17 December, a direct service to Geneva by SWISS was resumed and on 20 December Bees Airline launched its new service to Lviv. A new Eurowings service to Rome will be launched on 24

December 2021 and, in addition, Volotea has scheduled the resumption of its Prague – Bordeaux and Prague – Marseille flights for the Christmas period.

KOREAN AIR BACK IN PRAGUE FOR ONE RETURN FLIGHT

After a certain period of time, Korean Air landed its single return flight from Seoul at Václav Havel Airport Prague on 16 December 2021. The Airbus A330-300 aircraft returned to Korea a day later and, in accordance with the current travel restrictions on the



Korean side, only passengers with Korean passports, passport holders with the selected type of visa and passengers transferring in Seoul within 24 hours were able to board the aircraft. The return flight was designed primarily for the Korean community in the Czech Republic and surrounding regions. The resumption of regular flights will depend on the epidemiological situation and has not

yet been confirmed by the carrier.
