FIFTH FASTEST GROWING AIRPORT IN EUROPE

Last year, Václav Havel Airport Prague took the fifth place among the fastest growing airports in Europe within its category of 10 – 25 million handled passengers, recording a year-on-year growth of 17.9% and a record number of 15.4 million handled passengers. This year, the number of handled passengers should be close to 17 million.



NEW BOEING 737MAX OPERATED BY TRAVEL SERVICE

On 1 February 2018, Václav Havel Airport Prague ceremonially welcomed a new Boeing 737MAX of the Czech air carrier, Travel Service. It is the first aircraft of this type added in the carrier's fleet. The aircraft serviced the first commercial flight on the Malaga, Spain, route on 1 February 2018. In the next six years, deliveries of 38 more aircraft of this type should follow to expand the Travel Service's fleet.

CZECH AEROHOLDING TO RECEIVE THE HIGHEST A1 RATING

The Moody's Investors Service agency has confirmed the rating of A1 with a stable outlook awarded to Czech Aeroholding, the sole shareholder of Prague Airport, last year. In the decision rationale, Moody's noted the strong position of the airport as the main gateway to the Czech Republic with 97% share of passengers for

NEWS FROM AIRLINES

FIRST REGULAR DIRECT CONNECTION TO AMMAN

Ryanair, a low-cost carrier, has announced the launch of operations of its new route between Václav Havel Airport Prague and Amman in Jordan, making it the first regular scheduled connection with the country. The carrier plans to operate flights to the new destination twice a week with Boeing 737-800s for 189 passengers effective the end of October 2018.

NEW AIRPORT DEFIBRILLATORS

In the last week in January, seven Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) were installed around Václav Havel Airport Prague premises. The device is able to evaluate whether the patient needs a dose of electric current or not; its use is intuitive. All defibrillators are under uninterrupted CCTV camera surveillance and if opened, the alarm sounds at the central dispatch station.
