PRAGUE AIRPORT HANDLES OVER 340 THOUSAND PASSENGERS IN JANUARY



A total of 344,851 passengers were handled by Prague Airport in January 2022, representing a year-on-year increase of almost 300%. However, compared to 2019, it is still approximately one third of the period traffic (in January 2019, Prague Airport handled approximately 980,000 passengers). Paris, Amsterdam and London were among the busiest destinations in January 2022. More

NEW LONG-HAUL ROUTE TO SAUDI ARABIA

Effective 1 May 2022, Flynas is to connect Prague with Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. The new direct connection will be operated three times a week, on



Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays, using Airbus A320neo for 174 passengers in configuration of two travel classes: Premium and Economy. For now, the route will be serviced until the end of the 2022 summer schedule. Learn more [HERE](#).

AIR MONTENEGRO TO CONNECT PRAGUE WITH TIVAT



The Montenegro national carrier has announced a brand-new direct service from Tivat to Prague, which will connect the Czech Republic with Montenegro twice a week from 14 June until October 2022. The flights will be operated using the Embraer 195 type of aircraft with a capacity of 116 seats. The new air connection confirms in particular the importance of the Montenegro leisure market for

NEW OSLO AIR CONNECTION



As early as 7 April 2022, a new air service operated by the Flyr airline is to connect Prague with Oslo. At the beginning, the route will be frequented twice weekly. Effective 14 June, the frequency will increase to three weekly flights, operated on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. Flyr will use Boeing 737-800 with the capacity of 189 seats to operate the route.

CZECHS PLAN TO SPEND MORE MONEY ON TRAVELLING IN



Despite the worldwide pandemic, Czechs have not lost their interest in air travel. They plan to invest more money in their holiday abroad this year, as confirmed by a survey, conducted for Prague Airport among 1,565 respondents. Travel expenses belong to one of the few items on which Czechs do not plan to save. According to the poll, travelling is one of the top three categories in which the

PRAGUE AIRPORT REDUCES ITS CARBON FOOTPRINT BY 72%



Last year, Prague Airport reduced its CO₂ emissions by 72 percent compared to 2009. At the same time, it retained the carbon footprint certification issued under the Airport Carbon Accreditation (ACA) programme. Prague Airport thus belongs to the group of only 20 European airports committed to reducing the carbon footprint from their operations, as well as involving business partners in such effort.
