PRAGUE AIRPORT HANDLES NEARLY 4.4 MILLION PASSENGERS IN 2021



The 2021 was a year of partial recovery of air traffic and travelling, as evidenced by the last year's Prague Airport operational results, showing almost 4.4 million handled passengers. Compared to 2020, this is nearly a 20% increase. However, it still represents a drop of about 75% compared to the year 2019. The greatest number of passengers flew from Prague to Spain, Greece, and

Italy. Amsterdam, Paris, and London were among the most frequented destinations. A total of 52 carriers serviced their flights from Prague to 138 destinations on regular and charter routes in 2021. For more info visit [HERE](#)

EUROWINGS EXPANDS ITS DIRECT FLIGHT OFFER



Effective this March, Eurowings plans to expand the number of its direct air connections, adding four new routes. The carrier is to service Cologne and Stockholm twice a week effective 4 March 2022, while Larnaca is to be offered once a week starting 5 March 2022, followed by Alicante once weekly effective 6 March 2022. INCREASED NUMBER OF CONNECTIONS TO THE UNITED KINGDOM



This February, operations to selected destinations in the United Kingdom will be resumed. Eurowings re-launches its Birmingham route on 4 February, followed by Jet2.com on 11 February 2022. Bristol will be available again with Eurowings or easyJet from 4 February. Effective 11 February, the direct connection to Leeds, Newcastle and Manchester operated by Jet2.com will be back as well. The new routes

success could be supported by the easing of the UK entry restrictions effective 11

February. Fully vaccinated travellers will no longer need to present a negative PCR test result or to be self-isolated.
