DIRECT FLIGHTS FROM PRAGUE TO OVER HUNDRED DESTINATIONS



It is currently possible to travel to more than a hundred destinations from Vaclav Havel Airport Prague. It includes also services resumed in July as well as destinations with recently increased operation. In July, EasyJet resumed its service to Geneva while Transavia re-launched service to **Eindhoven**. Other routes saw the operation increase Barcelona (EasyJet), Larnaca e.g. (Cyprus Airways), Riga (Ryanair), Warsaw (Ryanair) and Bucharest (TAROM). Wizz Air launched direct services to several destinations, especially in Italy (Rome, Catania and Bari) while El Al has resumed a regular service to Tel Aviv. Traffic to Scandinavia was increased, with Norwegian's too, resumed services to Stockholm and Copenhagen and Ryanair's services to Stockholm and Gothenburg. VÁCLAV HAVEL AIRPORT PRAGUE PASSENGER NUMBERS CONTINUE TO GROW



As per the latest operational reports, nearly 290 thousand passengers passed through the gates of Vaclav Havel Airport Prague in June 2021, representing an increase of over 650 percent compared to June last year. Moreover, the number of passengers handled at Prague Airport in June 2021 has doubled compared to May this year. During June 2021, most passengers departing from Prague

travelled to Amsterdam, Rhodes or Frankfurt. Popular holiday destinations included Hurghada, Heraklion, Mallorca, Kos and other places mostly in Greece or Spain.

NIGHT-TIME OPERATIONS OF SHOPS AND RESTAURANTS AT VACLAV HAVEL AIRPORT PRAGUE



With increasing air traffic, airport shops, restaurants, cafés and other services are gradually resuming their regular hours of operation. Some of the places remain open nonstop to meet the demand of night-time travellers. Terminal 2 visitors can enjoy the services of the Bread & Co café, located in the public area of Terminal 2 Departure Hall, which remains open all night. Costa Coffee, located in the

restricted area of Terminal 2, also offers its services 24/7 to passengers who have passed security control. In the restricted area of Terminal 1, right behind the passport

control point, passengers can visit the Aelia Duty Free shop all day and night. Costa Coffee, located in the Terminal 1 Departure Hall public area, also operates nonstop.

PRAGUE AIRPORT MOVES TOWARDS CARBON NEUTRALITY



Prague Airport wants to be carbon neutral by 2030 with the help of new technologies, more economical sustainable fuels engines, and hydrogen or electric propulsion of aircraft. Therefore, Prague Airport has joined the International Association of Airports' (ACI) Net Zero initiative. The Net Zero initiative aims to achieve net carbon neutrality by 2050 at the latest. However, Prague Airport, through

particular steps, has been targeting a 2030 deadline and continuously reducing emissions of CO2 since 2010 when it joined the Airport Carbon Accreditation programme.
