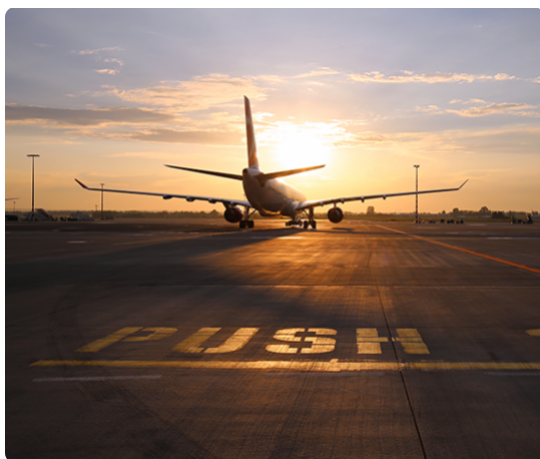

147 DESTINATIONS DIRECTLY FROM PRAGUE THIS SUMMER



Under the 2022 summer schedule, Prague Airport will offer direct connections to a total of 147 destinations operated by 58 air carriers, including the resumed Delta Air Lines' route to New York. Places such as Riyadh, Alicante, Almeria, Faro, Porto, Tivat, Mykonos, and Santorini will be newly added in the flight schedule. Several new carriers will also be introduced, such as Air

CZECH REPUBLIC RELAXES ITS CONDITIONS FOR TRAVEL



In coordination with other European Union countries, the Czech Republic has relaxed the conditions for entry into its territory effective 18 March 2022. Citizens of the European Union and seven other countries can enter the Czech Republic without any restrictions, whether they are vaccinated against Covid-19 or not. In addition to the European Union countries, the rule relaxation also
