

FLY DIRECTLY FROM PRAGUE IN NOVEMBER

Passengers can currently choose from approximately 40 destinations to which they can fly directly from Václav Havel Airport Prague. There are also direct flights to some popular holiday destinations, such as Egypt, Tunisia and the Canary Islands. However, it is always important for passengers to learn about the specific conditions of travel to their destination and back home. Airlines continuously evaluate the current epidemiological situation in the Czech Republic and abroad, with a special focus on the demand of passengers for travel. Therefore, carriers react to the situation very flexibly and adjust the offer of connections from Prague in their flight schedules. PUBLIC HEALTH PASSENGER LOCATOR FORM FOR ARRIVALS



All passengers travelling to the Czech Republic from the countries that are not on the list of the countries with a low risk of COVID-19 contagion have to fill the Public Health Passenger Locator Form before entering the country.

Online form is available on the

website <u>www.prijezdovyformular.cz</u>. After a completed form is sent, the passenger will receive a confirmation e-mail with the QR code and link. The form can be printed out or displayed on a mobile device and presented during passport control on arrival in the Czech Republic.

TEMPORARY DISRUPTION OF NIGHT-TIME OPERATIONS



Due to reduced air traffic caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, Prague Airport announces its plan to temporarily disrupt night-time operations of scheduled direct and charter passenger flights effective 1 December 2020. Departure restrictions will be in effect between

21:00 and 04:59 UTC. No arrivals will be accommodated between 22:00 and 4:59 UTC. This measure will not apply to cargo, emergency, diverted, business/general aviation, technical, ferry and other flights as listed in the conditions and details shared with all air carriers. The measure will remain in place until the end of the 2020/2021 IATA Winter schedule, 28 March 2020.
