VUELING LAUNCHES NEW ROUTE TO FLORENCE



Vueling operated its first flight between Prague and Florence on Sunday, 15 September 2019. The route will be serviced four times a week until the end of October, with flights offered every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. During the winter season, from

November until March, Vueling will offer three weekly services on Mondays, Fridays and Sundays. The route is operated with Airbus A319 aircraft for 144 passengers. On the occasion, Prague Airport and Vueling representatives hosted a celebration and a ribbon-cutting ceremony in Terminal 2 with refreshments served to the departing passengers.

inaugural flight enjoyed an official welcome at Václav Havel Airport Prague and received special gift bags upon their arrival with, for example, Prague maps and brochures, prepared by Prague City Tourism and Prague Airport on the occasion.

CZECH AIRLINES AND SMARTWINGS TO INCREASE OPERATIONS IN PRAGUE



Both Czech carriers are increasing the number of flights and capacities on their regular scheduled routes from Václav Havel Airport Prague in the upcoming winter season. Czech Airlines will increase frequencies on flights to Kyiv and Moscow and extend operations on routes to

Beirut and Odessa. The connection to Keflavík (Iceland), operated by Czech Airlines, will be available to passengers daily, as of now with a stopover in Copenhagen. On several routes, Czech Airlines will also increase the capacity by using larger aircraft. Smartwings will now offer more flights to Rostov-on-Don and St. Petersburg. The airline will also relaunch its service to Dubai, the United Arab Emirates.
