Prague Airport Achieves Estimated Growth a Year Early

Thanks to intensive route network resumption and successful cooperation with airlines, Prague Airport got close to the pre-pandemic numbers a year earlier than expected. This development confirms the successful transformation undergone by the airport. In the last twelve months, more than 100 new projects in the field of air connections development have been announced. As part of the upcoming winter flight schedule, passengers will be able to choose from the offer of connections to over 115 destinations. Václav Havel Airport Prague development projects are also continued. Next year, over 18 million handled passengers are expected.
