It's been a record-breaking year here in Prague! Now, that we can see the journey we took through the whole year 2025, I am proud of all our achievements and accomplishments, as the air cargo community. Along with our great business friends and partners, either airlines, forwarders, handlers, sales agents, and other service providers, we have shown dedication and persistence in this dynamic industry.

If I can interest you in some numbers, in 2025 we saw over 130,000 tonnes of cargo and mail handled at our airport, with over 96,600 tonnes transported by air. Both of these numbers topped our previous record from 2017 by significant margin and represent our growth in transported volume by 36% (45% by air only).

„Growth“ is the word I use frequently these days. It is closely connected with this issue, too. Though we are already comfortable with the course of the new year, let me, once again, wish you a happy and successful 2026. May it bring you peace, prosperity, and positive growth.

Fastest Growing Air Cargo Carrier at Prague Airport



Prague Airport has announced the best-performing airlines of 2025 across five different categories. The results reflect the airport's long-term focus on enhancing service quality and strengthening relationships with key partners — the airlines. Representatives of the winning carriers received their awards during a gala evening held as part of the airport's annual partner event.

The cargo carrier with the highest year-on-year increase in transported freight and mail in 2025 was **Central Airlines**, which launched a new cargo route between Chengdu, China, and Prague last year.
