## Small Play Areas for Children

Apart from the large children's play zone equipped with play structures, the airport also offers small play areas for children aged 3 to 8, where they can play with building blocks and toys for fine motor skills development. Since they are located directly at the gates, children can have some fun even right up until departure and have a more enjoyable travelling experience.

#### Terminal 1

- Pier A: Gate A7-9
- Pier B: Gate B7-9; B10-B18

#### Terminal 2

• End of Pier C and Gate C15

# Travelling with Children

## BEFORE DEPARTURE

Just like an adult, every child needs a valid travel document to travel abroad.

Liquids, including baby food necessary for the duration of the flight, have to be declared at the security checkpoint. Therefore, when packing your baggage, place them at the top of your baggage to speed up your passage through security.



## CHECK-IN

Parents travelling with children in pushchairs departing from Terminal 2 can use a designated lane at security control. In order to get to this lane easily, look out for the paper planes symbols that are displayed at the security checkpoint entrance.

Although baby food necessary for the duration of the flight is allowed on board without limitations, it has to be declared and presented for x-ray screening outside the baggage.

## Security Rules on Liquids, Aerosols and Gels



## Restricted Amount

There are certain restrictions on the amount of liquids in a single container you can carry in your hand baggage: Liquids and gels for regular use (cosmetics, food, etc.) in containers of 100 ml or less, with a total volume of up to 1 l.





## No Restrictions

The liquids you can carry in your hand baggage without any restrictions on the amount in a single container are:

- · children's and baby food for the duration of the flight,
- medication and special dietary food for the duration
- intact security tamper-evident bags purchased at the airport shops (STEBs).

It is recommended that you have a medical prescription or a doctor's note when taking medication and special dietary food on board.



# **GETTING AROUND THE AIRPORT WITH** YOUR OWN PUSHCHAIR

If you travel with your own pushchair, you can usually use it until boarding. Your pushchair is subject to security check, during which you will be asked to fold the pushchair and put it through the x-ray machine.

At the gate, the pushchair must be handed over to the handling company's staff that will make sure it is safely stored in the baggage compartment or in other designated area of the plane.

#### TIP

If you do not need to use your own pushchair to get through the airport, you can check it in at the check-in counter and hand it over at the oversize baggage counter. You can then borrow one of your pushchairs for free - they can be found behind the passport checkpoint in Terminal 1, behind the security checkpoint in Terminal 2 and at many other points in both terminals. You can borrow one of our pushchairs for free after your arrival at the airport as well.

## Family Rooms

If you are looking for somewhere quiet and private, there are special family rooms for parents with children at the airport. They are equipped with a changing table, a play area, a private bathroom and a kitchenette where you can, for example, heat up baby food for the youngest travellers. These rooms are located in both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2.

## **Changing Tables**

Changing tables are placed not only in the family rooms, but also in most women's and men's restrooms in both public and transit areas of the airport.

## Special Toilet Cubicles for Parents with Children

In selected restrooms in Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, there are cubicles for parents with children equipped with children's size toilets and sinks.

## Reasonably-priced Eating Options

In Prague Restaurant, you can choose either from the daily menu comprising a variety of Czech and international meals or from the fixed menu which includes two children's meals. There are high chairs available to use for free.
